**Lisa Rigstad: Open Borders**

Paint Creek Center for the Arts is pleased to present **Open Borders**, a one woman show in our First Floor Gallery, featuring recent paintings by Lisa Rigstad of Oak Park, Michigan. Lisa received her Bachelor of Fine Arts degree from Wayne State University and her Master of Fine Arts Degree from the University of Michigan. She is currently an adjunct faculty at the College for Creative Studies where she has worked since 2000.

Lisa Rigstad deals with the issues of painting contemporary landscapes. Lisa's paintings are rendered layered colors and textures to create haunting images filled with emotional content. She is best known for her intimate small works that present a sensitive, fragile pensive space. The artist says of her work, "The space, which is the erosion of our lives, incorporates everyday objects and symbols, leaving the viewer with a feeling familiarity but yet a bit uncomfortable as to their true meaning."
