

## 2010 STUDENT & FACULTY SHOW INFORMATION

The Student & Faculty show is open to all students who took classes between Spring 2009 and Spring 2010.

**The purpose of this show is to highlight the accomplishments of students and teachers in our program. Only works done during PCCA classes are eligible for entry.**

- **Submission dates:** Monday, May 10 – Saturday, May 15
- **Show runs** May 21 – June 11
- **Opening Reception** Friday, May 21, 6 – 8 pm

All work will be installed in the main (upstairs) gallery. Children and adult students may each submit two pieces. There will be no jury process, but we do reserve the right to decline any work that is inappropriate or is not submitted in good condition.

**Adult Student** works must be no larger than 24"x 36". Adult works on paper – watercolors, drawings, collages, photographs etc. – must be matted and framed. Paintings on stretched canvas do not need to be framed. Paintings on materials other than stretched canvas – canvas board, panels etc. – must be framed. **All two dimensional work must be ready to hang. This means screw eyes and hanging wire securely in place at the time of submission. PLEASE NO SAWTOOTH HANGERS.**

**Youth, Young Adult, and Pre-school student** works must be matted or mounted securely on mat board or railroad board. We will provide railroad board if teachers will assist in mounting works. Works must be no larger than 24" x 36". **Works on panels or similar materials must have hanging apparatus securely in place.**

**Faculty** may each submit **one** piece, **no larger than 24" x 36"**. Sculptural or ceramic pieces to be displayed on pedestals must also be limited in size to no larger than 24" x 24" x 36". Works must be framed and ready to hang. Paintings on stretched canvas do not need to be framed. **All two dimensional work must be ready to hang. This means screw eyes and hanging wire securely in place at the time of submission. PLEASE NO SAWTOOTH HANGERS.**

Artists must provide a sale price or insurance value for their work. PCCA will take a 30% commission on works sold, with any proceeds going to support our education programs.

**NEW THIS YEAR:** Adult student and faculty artists may participate in the Student & Faculty Tent at the new Art & Orchard Festival on Saturday and Sunday, June 12 & 13. If you wish to have your work from the Student & Faculty Show at PCCA presented in the Art & Orchard Tent, please check off the box on the Entry Form. PCCA staff will transport your work to the festival site on Friday, June 11 for display at the festival. Works will be returned to PCCA and available for pick up on Monday, June 14.

All works must be picked up between Monday, June 14 and Saturday, June 19, during regular business hours. Our storage space is very limited, and it is impossible to ensure safe storage of artwork beyond this date. **Pick-up dates apply to faculty as well as students. We are not responsible for works not picked up by the June 19 deadline.**

## CALL FOR ENTRIES

### Eligibility

Open to students and faculty of PCCA who have taken or taught classes from Spring 2009 - Spring 2010. Works may not exceed 24" x 36" in any dimension. Children's two-dimensional works must be mounted on railroad board or mat board, but do not need to be framed. Adult works on paper (students and faculty) must be matted and framed. All work must be ready to hang with appropriate hanging apparatus firmly attached. **Only works made during PCCA classes are eligible for entry.**

### Liability

PCCA is responsible for works on its premises between May 10 - June 19, 2010. We are NOT responsible for works delivered in poor condition, or works delivered prior to May 10 or left after June 19, 2010.

### Agreement

Entering work and entry form to PCCA shall constitute agreement with all conditions of this call for entries. Set up and display of work is determined by PCCA exhibition staff. Entries MUST remain on display until the end of the exhibition. PCCA reserves the right to reproduce entries for publicity purposes.

### Sales

Sales of artwork will be encouraged. Artists wishing to sell their work must indicate a sale price, to include a 30% commission. Proceeds will go toward PCCA education programs.

### Entry Procedure

Each student may submit up to two entries. Faculty may submit one entry. Entries will be accepted from May 10 - May 15. All work must be ready to hang and clearly labeled. Pieces larger than 24" x 36" will be displayed ONLY with approval from exhibition staff. Works delivered in fragile or damaged condition will not be accepted.

### Pickup of Exhibited Artwork

Due to limited storage space, all work must be picked up June 14 - June 19 during regular PCCA hours. Works left beyond this date become the property of PCCA. We are not responsible for the condition of artwork left beyond this date.

### Art & Orchard Festival

Adult students and faculty may have their works displayed in the Student & Faculty tent at the new Art & Orchard Festival. Works will be transported by PCCA staff. Work will be available for pick up at PCCA on Monday, June 14.
