ENTRY GUIDELINES

Entry fees: \$10 for ages 19 and under
\$15 per piece or \$40 for 3 entries for adults

ALL artistic mediums will be accepted.

Artists may enter one (1) piece of two or three dimensional artwork for \$15 fee. Discounted fee for 3 entries. There is no limit on the number of pieces an artist may enter.

ALL artwork must be original and created within the last (3) years and free standing pieces must be stable.

ALL two dimensional artwork must be mounted for hanging with a wire. No saw tooth hooks.

ALL artwork must be priced or marked NFS. The Orion Art Center (OAC) will collect a comission of 30% on all artwork sold during this exhibit.

ALL artwork, sold of otherwise, will remain on-site for the duration of the show.
